


HEADLINES

H1 FY24 Financials

- Good back-catalogue performance, led by CMS. Revenue from new games lower than expected
- Adjusted EBITDA loss of £4.9 million lower revenue/gross profit and slightly higher costs
- Operating loss before restructuring of £30.8 million after amortisation and impairment charges
- Cash at 30 November of £17.1 million, and £19.9 million at 31 December

Operations & strategy

- In Q4 we confirmed an updated CMS-focussed strategy, with three CMS games across FY25-27
- The Organisational Review supporting that updated strategy is on-track, including a 20% reduction in annual costs

Current trading & outlook

- Holiday trading was consistent with revised expectations
- Two PC games coming to consoles in the next few months (FY24)
- F1 Manager 2024 and an own-IP CMS game are on-track for release in FY25
- Financial guidance for FY24 reconfirmed



REVENUE

- Good back-catalogue performance £34.4 million of revenue from games which released before the start of the period (72% of total revenue)
- Within the back-catalogue, creative management simulation ('CMS') games achieved:
 - £26.3 million of revenue (55% of total revenue)
 - Equivalent to a sustain rate of 81% versus H1 FY23 (£32.6 million)
- Jurassic World Evolution 2 and Planet Zoo were the strongest performers, both supported by free updates and multiple PDLC packs
- Across the whole portfolio, PDLC accounted for 29% of total revenue in H1 FY24 (H1 FY23: 30%)
- The revenue contribution from new games launching during the period was lower than expected:
 - Revenue from the F1® Manager Franchise reduced 34% from H1 FY23 to H1 FY24 through lower sales of F1® Manager
 2023 compared with F1® Manager 2022
 - Lower than expected launch sales of Warhammer Age of Sigmar: Realms of Ruin



ORGANISATIONAL REVIEW

- Announced in October 2023 an Organisational Review to reshape Frontier to;
 - deliver more efficiently on the revised CMS-focussed strategy,
 - return the Company to profit,
 - create a sustainable foundation for the future.
- Cost reductions are a major element of the review, with a targeted reduction in annual operating costs of 20%
- Restructuring of roles has been undertaken in two phases:
 - Phase one (mostly non-dev) has now completed.
 - Phase two (mostly dev) will complete during February.
- The review is also delivering enhancements to Frontier's leadership, structure and processes



CURRENT TRADING AND OUTLOOK

- Holiday trading in-line with the revised expectations set in November 2023 strong CMS performance offsetting lower sales from some other games
- FY24 financial guidance maintained:
 - Revenue £80-95 million
 - Previous guidance for an Adjusted EBITDA* loss of £9 million remains achievable towards the upper end of the revenue range




